

monument intervention and a state and a st


history: "de windroos" is a housing development project build in 1925 by dutch architect piet kramer, a core designer of the "amsterdamse school". because of the dark brick façade, it is known as "the black house".











project: the actual owner desired a "light" addition facing the backyard: allowing maximum daylight to enter the living room, whilst respecting the building restrictions applied to the monument. the small extension is to be build, removed and rebuild within a single day: a galvanised steel structure is "clamped" between the brickwalls by means of a timber frame.
