






project: the competition brief requested an extension to the "simplicissimus haus" in renchen, a museum to honour johann jakob christoph von grimmelshausen, a popular 17th century writer. in order to bring a modest homage to the popular writer, the existing building is respected in its original state. the extension consists of a careful gesture: the distinct volume is linked to the existing through a light and transparent traditional wooden structure. in analogy to the typical barn, this light volume is in harmony with the small village.
