















concept: in order to underline the minimalistic architecture, the lighting scenography is based solely on the use of deeply recessed lighting fittings. two independent lighting schemes were developed: indirect lighting to emphasize the architectural features (concrete bench and staircase) and direct lighting for the task and representation functions (by means of discrete down lighters).
